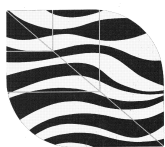

The present public hearings constitute the second of two phases of the public hearings led by the Federal and Provincial Review Panels under the *James Bay and Northern Quebec Agreement*. Phase II of the hearings offers an opportunity for the public to express their opinions on the project and its impacts and to present or file a submission.

Individuals who wish to present a submission or make an oral presentation at the hearings should notify either the secretariat of the Federal Review Panel South (COFEX-South) or of the Provincial Review Committee (COMEX) of their intention to do so prior to the hearings. During the hearings, priority will be given to individuals and groups that have informed the Panels of their intention in advance.
